**Durashia "Button" Frizzell
MAC (SW) USN (Retired)**

VETERAN OF THE QUARTER

Button graduated from Sanford-Fritch High School in 1988 and soon after married Russell Frizzell. She joined the Navy in 1989 and was shipped out to Boot Camp in Orlando Fl. Her first assignments were in Philadelphia where she served as an

Electrician's Mate onboard Naval Station Philadelphia and the USS Forestall, an aircraft carrier. In 1994 she was transferred to Shore Intermediate Maintenance Activity (SIMA) Guantanamo Bay Cuba where she spent a year and due to all dependents being evacuated off the Island. Button was transferred to Guam where she spent the next three years onboard the USS Holland and the USS Frank Cable both sub tenders (repair ships), though she spent most of her time in Sasebo and Yokosuka Japan. In 1998 she converted to the Master at Arms (MA) rating and attended the training academy at Lackland Air Force Base in San Antonio, Texas. She was assigned to NTC Orlando, Naval Hospital Pensacola, in Florida. Button was at Naval Air Station Keflavik Iceland where she worked as a Watch Commander on September 11, 2001. She was promoted to MA1, she also enjoyed becoming the DARE instructor teaching over 300 elementary students, Career Counselor and Security's Admin Officer. In 2003 she transferred to NTTC Lackland, as an instructor for Master at Arms training academy. She was also to work as the School Liaison/Administrative assistant. In 2006 Button transferred to Naval Air Facility Atsugi Japan, selected as Chief Petty Officer (CPO) where she served as a Watch Commander and the Training Officer, worked with the JMSDF training, and the Japanese Security guards. Her final duty station was NAS Corpus Christi. She worked with MWR and other organizations to have National Night Out on Base, which had not been done in a long time. Button was deployed for a year to JTF GTMO Detainee Operations and retired after 24 years. Button received several awards for her outstanding professionalism and leadership throughout her career.

Button is currently employed with Texas Veterans Commission as a Veteran Career Advisor with Employment Services where she has worked for eight years. She has provided several workshops to veterans and family members with resumes, Interview skills and assisting with navigating how to find employment. Button has volunteered to provide employment services for three veteran community outreaches over the last few months and she works with community resources and veteran organizations to assist veterans.

WANT TO BE A VA MEDICAL FOSTER HOME CAREGIVER?

If you answer yes to the following questions, you may be a good candidate to become a VA Medical Foster Caregiver:

- Do you have care giving experience?
- Do you live within the Valley Coastal Bend?
- Are you willing to provide 24 hour care, supervision, and living space to one or more Veterans living in your home?

HOME REQUIREMENTS

- Up to three Veterans per home
- Home owned/rented by caregiver
- Home is caregiver's daily place of residence
- Provide a home-like, safe care environment (via location, furnishings, and upkeep.)
- Pass an inspection by a VA team, comply with state and local licensure and regulations, and meet current National Fire protection Association Life Safety Code



CAREGIVER REQUIREMENTS:

- Complete an application and interview with the VA MFH Program Coordinator
- Must be financially stable
- Must be at least 21 years old
- Experience providing care (formal or informal)
- Meet semi-annual training requirements
- Agree to a criminal history check
- Provide personal and work related references
- Physical ability to provide care
- A written back up plan and list of relief caregivers who can provide assistance
- Communicate with the Home Based Primary Care (HBPC) Team should significant changes occur (appearance, behavior, state of health)
- Accept and follow the Veteran's treatment plan
- Accept and follow the VA MFH rules and guidelines.

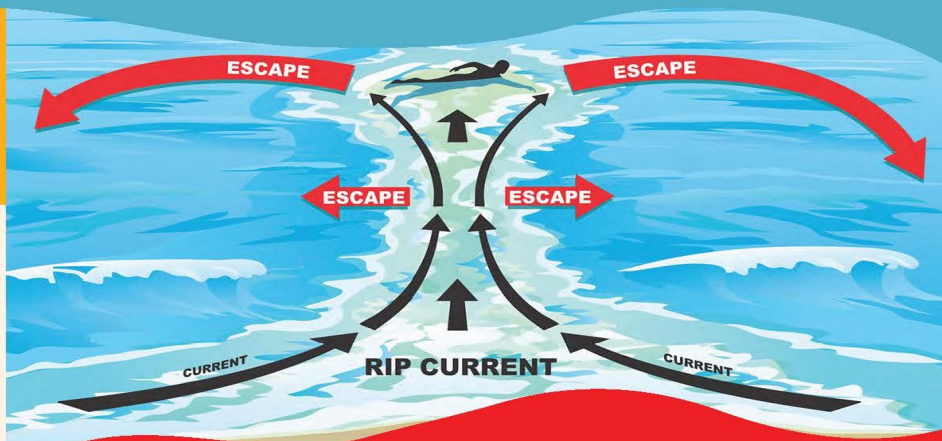
